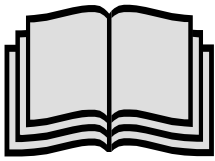

Christmas & New Year have passed and already one month into 2010—yesterday I saw Easter Eggs at the Supermarket—I don't know about anyone else but that seems a mite early.

The last 2 months have been steady with several incidents reported & some files outstanding:

1. Dog attacks Sheep—Hindon Road, TGR report pig dogs seen to be worrying sheep on 28 November, following day farmer finds 12 dead sheep in paddock.
2. Unlawfully takes Bicycle—Bolton Street, Sutton, 1 x Bauer Misty girls bicycle, teal green colour, solid shaped frame & in good condition.
3. Wilful Damage—Strath Taieri School reports sports shed broken into & tennis net broken—local youth spoken to by Police, admits breaking tennis net but denies entering sports shed.
4. Theft—Macraes Road, between 2—4 January 2010—1 x Gallagher brand solar panel for electric fence unit taken from roadside electric fence set up.
5. Wilful Damage—fishing huts at Loganburn Dam—attempts made to break into huts, entry not gained but door handles broken & discarded by offender/s.
6. Theft ex. Dwelling—Summerhills—T & G flooring cut from floor of old cottage, approx. 30 square metres taken.
7. Unlawfully takes Bicycle—Mold Street, Middlemarch, overnight 13 January, 2010, 1 x boys sea blue-green colour BMX style bicycle taken from outside address.

New Years Eve saw me being seconded to Hawea for 2 night shifts. It was relatively quiet and only 5 arrests made for New Years Eve (yes—I got one!)

I have the car back & I have been writing tickets!!! Thursdays will see me on the Taieri trying to achieve the dreaded quota—I am currently running at about 70% so are getting nudged to do more!

Police Ten 7 has ended its season on an all time high with viewer generated information helping Police make 43 arrests during the year. Since Police Ten 7 first went to air in 2002, information from the crimes and wanteds shown has helped Police resolve more than 400 cases.

No two cases the same in property splitting—the Matrimonial Property Act 1976 started off the concept of equal division 30 years ago but this Act has been amended several times and given a scrub up, and a name change to The Property(Relationships) Act 1976 The Act applies to married spouses, civil unions, de facto & gay relationships. Basic rule—if you live with someone for more than 3 years—everything is divided equally. Section 13 of the Act states there shall be equal sharing unless there are extraordinary circumstances—this would be best discussed with your

Lawyer. For more info visit www.justice.govt.nz

For those who require any statutory declarations to be signed and notarised—I am able to do this service.

Remember, if you have something to report, notice anything suspicious or amiss, not happy with some situation, want a raffle drawn or just to talk, ring the Police.

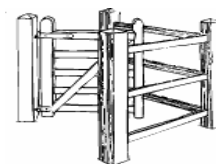

PLAY CENTRE NEWS 2010

Many of you in the community will have seen that play centre now has a new fence. This fence has been many years in the making and it's great to finally see it up. I would like to express our sincere Thanks to everyone who has helped with the massive project from parents who have helped with fundraising at train BBQs to raffles to asking for donations right through to those who turned up in the holidays to pull down the old fence and help put up the new one. Many Thanks to Cameron Macaulay who helped us out with putting it up, your expertise was greatly appreciated.

As a result of this Play centre has had to increase our fees per term. These will now be \$30.00 for the first child and \$10.00 for the following children. There will still be no charge for under 1's. Casual fees have also increased to \$5.00 a session. Fees will also need to be paid at the start of each term or a 50% penalty will apply. This has arisen due to some parents not paying fees at all. The committee feels it's only fair those who do pay on time are not subsidizing those who don't. However if you are new member your first 3 visits are free under Play centre association guidelines.

Please remember as we are unlicensed you must stay with your child at all times whilst at play centre.

We have some very exciting ideas planned for the children this year including trips away- a visit to the mine, farm visits etc. So we ask that you dress your child appropriately for play centre as over the summer there will lots of water play.

Play Centre is also on the look out for some ride on toys (suitable for the kids to play on outside) an arm chair for feeding mothers, oven and small fridge. If you have any thing that you feel might be of use to us please call in and see us.

We will once again be hitting the fundraising wagon so look out for us or keep us in mind if you have an idea/ job that could be suitable for us. Starting with Friday train BBQ February 5th so please play centre parents put this in your diary now!!
