**Police News**

The last month has been varied with several incidents reported and some files outstanding:

1. Trespass - vicinity Shannon, farmers report persons on property shooting/poaching animals
2. Theft Animals - Hyde - 7 cattle beasts missing from farm - enquiries continuing
3. Unlawfully in Building - Middlemarch Golf Club report disturbing 2 youths in mower shed - appears nil taken
4. Theft Animals - Nenthorn Valley - 4 lambs reported taken from deer yards of neighbouring address

Winter conditions now exist on our roads and care must be taken. Watch out for ice, snow and grit and look to carrying chains. Snow has already fallen and road conditions can vary greatly from day to day. And, if the road is closed - it is closed to everyone! If you have a traffic crash and Police advise your insurers the road was in fact closed, you will have no insurance.

Drugs and Driving - from 1 November, 2009 Police can carry out compulsory breath tests on drivers they suspect of driving whilst impaired by drugs. The test involves eye test, pupil size, reaction to light and ability to focus, a walk and turn test and a one leg stand test. Just like you see on American TV shows.

From 1 July, 2010 PSO's - Police Safety Orders have come into affect. Police can issue a PSO in circumstances where there is insufficient evidence to arrest a person of a family violence offence but where Police have reasonable grounds to believe the order is necessary to ensure the safety of the other persona the address. The PSO can be issued for 1-5 days and requires that person to leave their home for up to 5 days.

Police are using 'Facebook' to gather intelligence from local communities. Recent stats show 39% of New Zealanders use Facebook and this trend towards social networking sites seems likely to remain popular. Queenstown Police had success when loads of CCTV video footage was unable to identify an offender taking off his balaclava during a burglary. Photo stills were put onto Facebook and 2 days later Police knew the identity of the offender. The fastest result, however, was from CCTV of a shoplifter in a Queenstown chemist shop - it took only 34 minutes for the public to identify the offender!

For those who require any statutory declarations to be signed and notarised—I am able to do this service.

Remember, if you have something to report, notice anything suspicious or amiss, not happy with some situation, want a raffle drawn or just to talk, ring the Police.

The All Blacks are back, led by one of Canterbury's(!!!) own and are on the right path to showing the Irish and Welsh how things will go next year at the World Cup.

**Fire Brigade News**

It has been a busy month for the Fire Brigade. On the 4th June we attended a vehicle accident at Deep Stream where a vehicle had slid on an icy patch of road and hit a bank. Some injuries were suffered by the occupants.

On the 6th June we held a farewell function for Simone, Doc and their family. It was a great night and special thanks to all who came. It was quite overwhelming for them.

The brigade held its annual meeting on the evening of the 19th. It was a low key meeting this year but my thanks to all who made the effort to attend. In my annual report I noted that the brigade had attended 33 call-outs for the year ending 31st March and they were:-

Rubbish/Vegetation and the like	11
Chimney Fires	2
Vehicle/Machinery Fires	3
Motor vehicle accidents/crashes	10
Medical/Ambulance assist	4
Police assist	1
False alarms	2

Interestingly with such a large number of call-outs, there were no structure fires. I hope that is a good indication that fire safety awareness is alive and well within the community.

A major upgrade to the station office and turn-out system has just been completed. There has been a change to the way in which the siren operates, and members will be responding more through pager notification of an incident and less on the siren sounding. Throughout the day the siren will now sound for a maximum of 90 seconds and then will turn itself off. However between the hours of 9pm and 7am the siren will be on a three minute delay, i.e. if a call is not answered within 3 minutes, the siren will then sound. Likewise if the call is answered within the three minutes the siren will not sound at all. It will be interesting to see if members can get to the station in less than the three minutes. Fire sirens have been a part of rural community life for many years, and in some ways it is sad to see their use diminish. However it must be remembered that some volunteer brigades answer a large number of calls and it is unfair to regularly disturb communities with a siren, particularly at night.

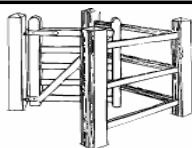

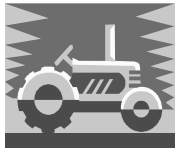

## Fuel situation

As you are probably aware, we are having issues with our fuel card machine at Trail Journeys. It is regretful that this new system we have put in has been unreliable from the day we had it installed. Trail Journeys are disappointed that the advice we were given from GAS to install this type of system has been bad advice. We have spent in excess of \$30,000 in putting the card system and new pumps into the site. This investment is certainly not a commercially profitable situation for us and we did so to provide a service for the local community as we realised the importance of having fuel available for the community.

The company that provided the card machine has been very difficult to deal with and will not repair the machine unless we agree to sign a form that indicates we will pay for any repairs to the machine. I am afraid that we are not prepared to do this as we believe that if you purchase a machine it should be reliable and do the job

it was intended to do and the part that has failed now is a part that has already been replaced which the company tried to bill us in excess of \$1800.00 for.

I am sorry for the inconvenience that this situation is causing to the community, but please do not take it out on Terina, or us, for that matter. It is one that we find difficult to deal with and are pursuing an answer from GAS to resolve it. I will be going to the consumer institute to see if a company that has sold the machine can contract out of providing repairs to a machine that has been unreliable from day one. This may take some time to resolve and if they are not prepared to fix the machine and make it reliable, I will be asking them to take it back and refund what has been paid and we will source another reliable machine which I have been told are in the market.

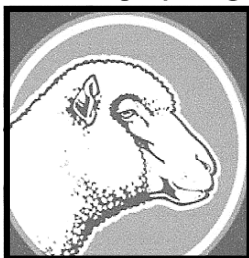
